

RDFCC - Club Kit Review Policy

Overview

A "review" of Club Kit will be the process of changing the Club Kit, Race or Leisure, from it's current design.

Club Kit comprises primarily the Jersey (Short & Long), Shorts and Skinsuit.

The RDFCC Club Kit can be reviewed only once every 5 years. The review will be a 2 stage process.

The complete process should last no longer than 4 months in total.

Stage 1 (GATE)

There will be a vote by Club Members (those who have up to date subs). The vote will be a Yes/No vote on changing the Club Kit from the current design.

The vote will take place at the a monthly Club Meeting. Members can either vote at the meeting or prior to the meeting by email or post. Each Member will have one vote only.

There will be at least a 1 month notice period of the vote.

At least 25% of Club Members must vote Yes for the review to be carried forward to Stage 2. If the 25% Yes vote is not reached, the kit shall remain the same and the Review will not be carried forward to Stage 2.

Stage 2

If 25% of Club Members vote Yes at Stage 1, designs can be submitted to the Club Committee by Members and the Committee may choose to employ a 3rd party to design the club kit.

A time limit will be set for the submission of new club designs by the Committee. A list of design guidelines will be set by the Committee if required. The Committee will then choose some or all of the designs for a vote by Club Members. If no designs are submitted the review will not continue.

A vote on the new kit design will take place at the a monthly Club Meeting. There will be at least a 1 month notice period of the vote.

Members can either vote at the meeting or prior to the meeting by email or post. Each Member will have one vote only for one design of kit.

At least 25% of Club Members must vote for the kit to be changed. The kit with the most votes will become the new club kit.

The Club Committee will actively promote the use of the new Club Kit so that it becomes widely used by Club Members as quickly as possible. The Club Committee will look to subsidise the new Club Kit where possible to encourage it's use.
